Friday, February 17:

6-7pm: Birding by Ear, Part 1*

Indoor talk about tips and techniques for picking out specific bird calls! This program is for individuals or families with children 12 years and up. This program is \$2/person.

Saturday, February 18:

7:30-8:30am: Birding By Ear, Part 2*

Guided walk on the trails to practice the new skills learned from the previous night. Participants should wear good walking shoes, comfortable clothes and bring plenty of water.



9-10am: "Birding 101" Guided Nature Walk

Join us for an hour walk through the trails with a preserve staff member to observe, hear and learn about different birds found at the preserve. Binoculars and field IDs are loaned on a first come, first served basis. The walk is for all ages, but all children attending must be accompanied by an adult.



10:30-11am: Story Time

We will be reading several bird-related stories near the playground.

11am-12pm: Nature & Crafts

Contribute to our newest bird mural that will be displayed in our multi-purpose room. Children of all ages get to draw, cut, paint and color birds to glue onto the mural. Meet at the amphitheater.

12-12:30pm: Peregrine Falcon Presentation (Texas Seaside Center)

Come and meet Larry, the Peregrine Falcon! He permanently resides at the Texas Seaside Center with a hurt wing. Hear all about Larry's story while learning more about the center and what they do there. Meet at the Amphitheater.
