The watershed for Oso Creek and Oso Bay includes most of the Corpus Christi and Robstown area. Often education resources focus on famous but distant examples of concepts such as Amazon rainforests and the African Serengeti. We will equip teachers with local knowledge to educate their students about science concepts using examples where students live.

Our workshop will focus on the Oso Creek watershed as a complete example of a watershed from rainfall to the ocean, the impact of human activity on the watershed, and how to integrate our needs and the needs of the environment. This workshop will leave teachers with multiple *ready-to-go* activities for their classroom that highlight local examples of science concepts and the complexity of these issues locally. Teachers will visit several sites on Oso Creek and Oso Bay and hear from experts from this area to understand the processes we discuss and how they play out in our critical urban watershed.
