Birding by Ear! Learn to identify local bird calls.

- Two-part workshop! This workshop is intended to teach some basic skills and techniques to learn local birds by sound, such as Painted Buntings, White-eyed Vireos, Cardinals, Mockingbirds, Doves, and more.
- Friday night's session will be an indoor classroom about tips and techniques for learning specific bird calls.
- Saturday morning will be a guided walk to practice your new skills on our nature trails.
- Participants should dress for the weather, wear good walking shoes, bring plenty of water, and possibly a small camp chair to carry.
- The fee is **\$2** per workshop and is open to individuals and families with children age 12 and older. All children attending the program must be accompanied by an adult.

- Binoculars and field guides will be provided during the program.
